Take advantage of free credit monitoring services designed specifically by the <u>national credit bureaus</u> for service members. Visit each bureau's website for eligibility information.

EQUIFAX

- View notifications of important changes to your credit report.
- Access your Equifax credit report daily.
- Receive automatic fraud alerts.
- Get identity theft insurance coverage up to \$25,000.



- Check your latest credit information for accuracy.
- Review an updated report every 30 days.
- Receive daily alerts when important changes occur.
- Transfer information through a private, secure connection.

TransUnion.

- Quickly and easily lock and unlock your credit information.
- Get instant alert notifications when someone applies for credit in your name or when critical credit information changes.
- Access unlimited credit report refreshes.
- Receive identity theft insurance up to \$25,000.
