- ✓ View notifications of important changes to your credit report.
- ✓ Access your Equifax credit report daily.
- ✓ Receive automatic fraud alerts.
- ✓ Get identity theft insurance coverage up to \$25,000.

experian™

- ✓ Check your latest credit information for accuracy.
- ✓ Review an updated report every 30 days.
- ✓ Receive daily alerts when important changes occur.
- ✓ Transfer information through a private, secure connection.

TransUnion™

- ✓ Quickly and easily lock and unlock your credit information.
- ✓ Get instant alert notifications when someone applies for credit in your name or when critical credit information changes.
- ✓ Access unlimited credit report refreshes.
- ✓ Receive identity theft insurance up to \$25,000.
